

How to Enroll Your Child in the Montessori School of Pullman

Many families discover our school through a recommendation of a colleague or family friend. When you call or email for more information, we will recommend that you also come for a visit. Your first visit will consist of a tour, a description of the Montessori Method of Education, a chance to have your questions answered, and some information to take away with you to read. We will invite you to stay and observe the children and teachers working together in the Montessori classrooms. This is the best way to find out what Montessori Education really means.

As our students remain with us for three years, space for new students is limited. Each year, about a third of our students graduate out of our program, making space for new students. Because of this, we recommend that you visit the Montessori School of Pullman when your child is two years old, or the year before you are considering enrollment. This is especially the case if you need morning or all day classes, as these fill quickly. Visiting early allows you to make repeated visits and make an informed decision on whether our school is a good fit for your family. We want to be with you for years to come!
